Overview of the Year 8 Curriculum Head, Heart & Hand

I hope that you have found the previous curriculum overviews helpful.

To ensure that we have clarity and consistency across the curriculum I have shared with you that we use the Head, Heart and Hand model where:

Head represents the key knowledge to be learned.

Heart represents the key personal skills that will be developed and help students to understand the world around them.

Hand represents the key skills that will be developed as a result of the knowledge learned.

I am keen that you as parents and carers have the opportunity to share in the Head, Heart & Hand curriculum so that you have an awareness of what your children are learning about, what new knowledge they are covering and what new skills they are developing.
