








MAKING THE 60 MATTER If you get a 1 or a 2 in class – you grab a further point for your House!



- 3. Set your Daily Goal and continue (you can change this later).
- 4. Create a Profile:

 - On iOS, press Profile in the top left corner and press Create a Profile.
- 5. Type in your Name, Email and Password, then press Create.
- 6. Go to your Profile and press Progress Sharing.
- 7. Type in your Classroom Code: GGPBPZ
