



Statement of condition of funding 16-19 Tuition Fund

Overview

The Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) have made £96 million of one-off funding available nationally for the 2020 to 2021 academic year only. It is ring fenced funding for schools, colleges and all other 16 to 19 providers to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from coronavirus (COVID-19).

Who can be supported by this fund?

The funding will support small group tuition for 16 to 19 students in English, maths and other courses where learning has been disrupted. Principally at Malbank Sixth Form College we will be focussing on students without a grade four or above in GCSE Maths and/or English.

What will Malbank Sixth Form College do?

At Malbank Sixth Form College the funding will be used to allow students to draw a line under last year, encourage them to focus on working to examinations when they feel ready and to provide direction, focus and support at the most pertinent points in the academic year ahead.

The following activities will take place as appropriate throughout the academic year

- Each student will have a learning plan to record their starting points and track their progress.
- One to one and small group learning and progress discussions with a PSM tutor to ensure each learner stays on track.

- Small group tuition where possible and in addition to timetabled resit sessions will focus on areas of Maths and English that were disrupted during 2020 to help fill gaps in knowledge.
- Online learning will also support learners in areas of English and Maths they are struggling with.
- Additional supervised sessions on study skills will help boost learners' chances of success in their assignments and exams.
