


Unit Intent

You will study the beliefs and teachings of Judaism and their basis in Jewish sources of wisdom and authority. You will also be encouraged to see how these teachings appear in Jewish scripture and/or sacred texts and how these beliefs and teachings influence individuals, communities and societies.

You should understand throughout that there are common and different views within Judaism in the way beliefs and teachings are understood and expressed: for example, Orthodox, Reform and Liberal Judaism.
