Footway improvements are starting in your area

What is happening

Beam Street, Nantwich is to be closed for footway improvement works that will see pedestrian and road safety enhancements including the upgrade of the zebra crossing, new kerbing, and central island improvements.

When is it happening

The work will take approximately 18 weeks to complete, commencing on 27 June 2022. In line with current health and safety legislation and for the safety of our workforce and members of the public, it will be necessary for a road closure to be in place. However, one side of the footpath along Beam Street will remain open at all times allowing access businesses or properties.

The road will be closed in phases under 24 hour closures until the scheme is complete:

Phase 1	Manor Road to junction adjacent to Pepper Street
Phase 2	Manor Road to outside of Hays Travel
Phase 3	Outside of Hays Travel to the crossroad traffic lights

While this work is ongoing , the taxi rank outside of B&M will be relocated during phases one and two to High Street.

Following completion of the footway improvements, we will be taking the opportunity to resurface the road at Beam Street in October. More information regarding this will be issued in due course.

Sometimes, our works change at short notice due to unforeseen circumstances – any changes or delays will be publicised on our website.

Diversion route information

There is a signed diversion in place while the road is closed and members of the travelling public are advised to:

- Head north-east on Beam Street towards Millstone Lane
- Turn right onto Millstone Lane/B5074
- At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit and stay on Millstone Lane/B5074
- At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto Hospital Street/A534
- At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Pratchetts Row/A534
- Continue to follow A534
- At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto Water-Lode/B5341

Access to your property or businesses

We understand there is no right time to undertake these improvements but the scheme has been carefully planned to minimise disruption to local residents, businesses and members of the public.

Please note, this letter does not grant you access through the road closure. If you have any specific access requirements, please raise these with our site supervisor as soon as possible.

All businesses in the area will remain open as usual for the duration of the works.

Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Keeping you informed

Your safety and the safety of our workforce is our main concern. Our traffic management officers are supplied with CCTV cameras and will be on site during the scheme to assist you as it progresses.
